Manufacturing Pre-Apprenticeship Certificate

Develop entry-level skills to start a career in manufacturing. Students will earn a Registered Pre-Apprenticeship Certificate from the PA Department of Labor & Industry.

Training includes:

1 Occupational Safety & Health Administration (OSHA) 10-hour general industry card.

2 Two National Institute for Metalworking Skills (NIMS) credentials in measurement; material and safety; and job planning, benchwork and layout.

3 Three National Tooling and Machining Association (NTMA) credentials in precision machining technology, blueprint reading; and quality control, statistical process control and inspection.
